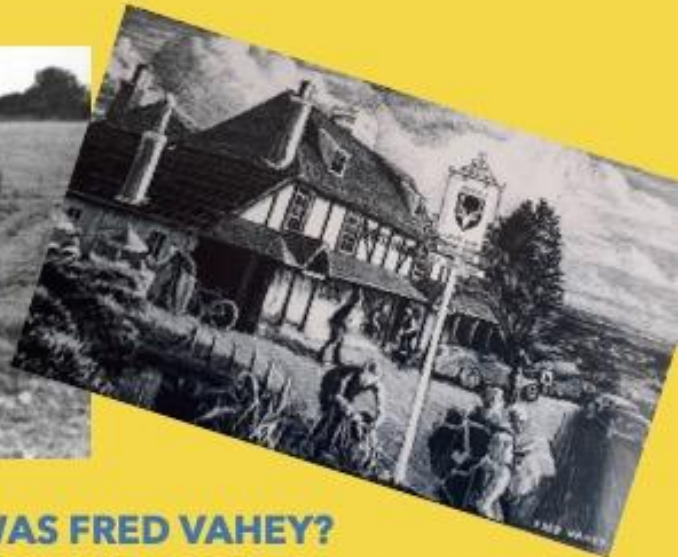

WHO WAS FRED VAHEY?

Fred and his wife, Zoe, were a unique couple who moved to Pannel Lane, Pett in 1938, to live off the land. Fred was a Conscientious Objector and spent the war years working the land. Known for his scraper board art he also made wooden clogs for his family who initially lived in a gypsy caravan until Fred half finished a self-built cottage, 'Innisfree'. Zoe spun wool from their sheep and made her own cloth, and clothes, wrote an illustrated history of Pett and was a keen archeologist, as well as a great friend of Spike Milligan!
